Description / Abstract

Participatory research approaches are increasingly popular with scientists working for poverty alleviation, sustainable rural development, and social change. This introduction offers an overview of the special issue of 'Development in Practice&' journal on the theme of 'operationalising participatory research and gender analysis'.
