- A. Monitoring: Innovative monitoring for EWS
- **B. Warning Dissemination**: Innovative ways to disseminate early warnings
- **C. Communication and Awareness Raising**: Innovative approaches to increase the preparedness and ability of the population to react appropriately to warnings
- **D. Impact mapping**: Innovative mapping of hazard impacts to improve the understanding of the vulnerability and feed back into the EWS to enhance it.

WHAT TO SUBMIT

Stage 1:

Submit a <u>video presentation</u> (up to 3 minutes) of your idea and information about yourself/your team/organization.

Stage 2:

Upon selection, submit a <u>Concept Note</u> detailing your proposal

Stage 3:

Finalists will give a **Live Pitch** to a jury

Eligibility Criteria

Submission deadline:

Stage 1 | 15 December 2021 Stage 2 | 17 February 2022 Stage 3 | To be announced

- Should be youth-led (age 15-35) activities/project and include youth participation across all aspects of the project
- Projects have to be result-oriented with clear objectives.
- Projects should be implemented within a maximum 6 months
- Research ideas and projects from the following are encouraged:
 - Social innovation and entrepreneurship ideas
 - University students/researchers projects
 - Women-lead projects
- The submissions can be done by any individual/ youth led organisations/team of young professionals
